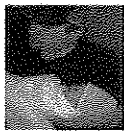

**ECP Faculty Position Opening:**

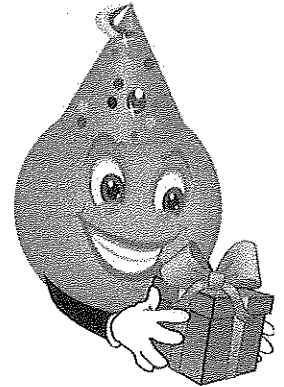
The Early Childhood Program has a faculty position opening in the nursery. We are looking for someone loving, dependable and with prior experience. Please call 471-9995 for an interview.

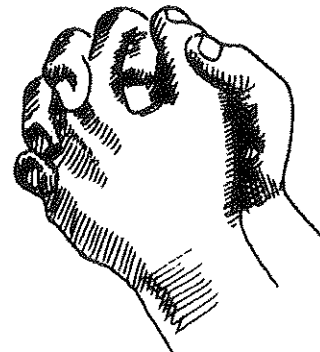

Open my heart

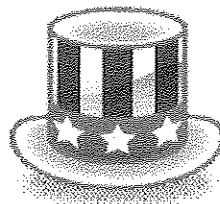
Not to just those who are close to me, but to all humanity.

Empathy and love.

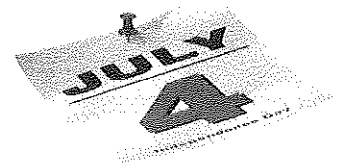

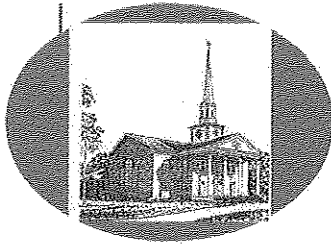
